A non-mandatory site visit and pre-bid meeting has been scheduled for **Thursday, December 19, 2013** at 10:30 AM in front of the construction gate located at the Brooklyn College Campus, intersection of Campus Road and Hillel Place, Brooklyn, NY. Bidders, their subcontractors and suppliers and all other interested subcontractors and suppliers are strongly recommended to attend. Bidder must sign in under the company name that will be submitted in the bid. Failure of the Bidder to visit the site and become familiar with site conditions will not relieve Bidder from responsibility to include all Work required to complete the Project in its Total Lump sum bid Amount.

All requests for information (RFI) must be in writing and must be received by Hill via fax to 212-244-3740 or via email to Kelly Adams at <u>kellyadams@hillintl.com</u> by no later than **4:00 PM** on **January 2**, **2014** in order to obtain response by written addendum prior to bid opening. Any questions or requests for clarification received after this time and date may be answered at the discretion of CUCF. However, all Bidders should assume that the **January 2**, **2014** – 4:00 PM deadline is final. Bidders are encouraged to submit any RFI as early as possible.

Bidder will be required to demonstrate that it is an organization doing business for a minimum of five (5) years prior to the bid opening date as documented by the New York State Department of State, has successfully completed within the last five years at least three projects of similar size and scope with at least one being a theater or concert hall; and has subcontractors with experience in the installation of theatrical sound and lighting systems, acoustical treatments for sound isolation and attenuation, and the installation of theatrical rigging systems of similar scale and complexity to the proposed project, and is capable of self-performing a minimum of 10% of the Work of the Contract. Bidder shall submit; a Bid Form (included in the Project manual of the Bid Documents); project list confirming the bidder satisfies experience requirements; proof of insurance; proof of bonding capacity; Bid Bond (10% of Bid) in the approved form; the Experience Modification Rate for the past three (3) years (as set forth in the Safety Questionnaire); as well as any other documents requested within the Bid Documents. The MBE goal for this project is 12%; the WBE goal is 8%. The successful bidder will be responsible for all licenses, permits, insurance and agency sign-offs with respect to the Work of the Contract for the duration of the contract. All work is being performed under and the bidder will be required to assent to the terms of a Project Labor Agreement. See the Bid Documents for a description of the project scope, bid requirements & procedures.

The overall project is for a new 64,000 s.f. performing arts center addition to an existing building. The Work of this Contract is for interior finishing and fit-out of the primary performance space, a 250-seat recital hall/ theater and ancillary spaces. The Work of the Contract will be simultaneous with the completion of construction under another Contract and with other Work performed by the Owner. The expected construction cost range is between \$11,500,000 and \$13,000,000. This project has time critical time constraints. Contract Work is expected to begin by **March 1, 2014**, and attain Substantial Completion of the Project, by **November 15, 2014**. This must be taken into account in the bid pricing.
